AUTHORIZED ALLOWANCE OF AMMUNITION
MAGAZINE ASSEMBLIES

I. REFERENCES:

SOP No. 09-18 NHQ-PCG/CG-11 dated 09 November 2018, Subject: Issuance of Ammunition Allowances to PCG Units.

II. PURPOSE:

To prescribe the authorized allowance of ammunition magazine assemblies per type of weapons in the PCG inventory.

III. DEFINITION OF TERMS:

a. Ammunition Basic Load – the specific quantity of ammunition authorized for such weapon required to be in the possession of a unit.

b. Ammunition Individual Load – quantity of ammunition authorized to be carried by an individual coastguardsman considered as part of the basic load. Such quantity can be increased and/or decreased depending on the assessment of the Unit Commander on the mission/task being performed by the unit.

c. Magazine Assembly – is a device used to contain the ammunition and used as a feeding mechanism to complete the functioning cycle of a magazine fed weapon.

d. Report of Survey Board – a report of two or more officers appointed or designated by proper authority to determine the pecuniary liability of responsible officer for lost, damage, stolen or worn supply or equipment/property entrusted to them other than faire wear and tear (FWT).

e. Property Turn-In-Slip – this form shall be used for turning-in to the supply installation of next higher level all excess and unserviceable supply or properties.

IV. AMMUNITION ALLOWANCES:

Listed herein is the prescribed authorized allowance for magazine assemblies per type of weapons based on the existing ammunition individual load cited in the aforementioned reference:

NOMENCLATURE	AMMO IN LOAD	NR OF MAGAZINE ASSEMBLIES
Pistol, Caliber 9 mm	28	2- (14 rds cap)
Pistol, Caliber .45	14	2 (7 rds cap)
Sub Machine Gun (SMG), Caliber 9 mm	200	4- (30 rds cap) & 4 (20 rds cap)
Rifle, 5.56 mm	200	4- (30 rds cap) & 4 (20 rds cap)
Rifle, 7.62 mm	80	4 -(20 rds cap)

V. GENERAL POLICIES:

a. The ammunition magazine assembly authorized allowance as prescribed in para IV shall be issued together with the corresponding type of weapons.

b. Magazine assemblies issued to an individual Coastguardsman shall be covered by Inventory Custodian Slip (ICS).

c. Weapons turned-in or transferred due to the deactivation of the corresponding unit/s, reduction of the number of troops, etc. shall be with the issued magazine assemblies.

d. Unserviceable magazine assemblies shall be turned-in to PCG SAO with the

duly accomplished PTIS. Said PTIS shall be attached to the request for replacement of said magazine assemblies addressed to PCG (Attn: DCS for MCWEIS).

VI. RESPONSIBILITY:

a. The Deputy Chief of Staff for Maritime Communication, Weapons, Electronics and Information System

1. Shall exercise functional supervision on the implementation of this SOP and shall provide appropriate directives for the issuance/distribution of magazine assemblies available stock at PCG SAO and CGWS.

2. Program for the acquisition and allocation of magazine assemblies.

b. Commander, CGWCE/ISC and Commanding Officer, CGWS shall insure the proper implementation of this SOP and recommend the issuance of magazine assemblies based on the authorized allowances per weapons in their inventory.

c. Unit Commanders are responsible for material readiness and maintenance of the authorized allowance of magazine assemblies for the weapons in their inventory.

VII. EFFECTIVITY:

This SOP shall take effect upon approval.
