WCEIS BADGE (DAGLIS-BUDYONG)

- I. REFERENCE:**
 - a. HPCG Circular No. 06-10 dated 24 May 2010 "PCG Awards and Decorations"
 - b. NHQ-PCG Circular No. 10-19 dated 12 July 2019 "Hazardous Duty Pay"
- II. PURPOSE:** This circular prescribes the eligibility, authority and policies governing the award of the WCEIS Badge (DAGLIS-BUDYONG).
- III. OBJECTIVE:**
 - a. To give identification to personnel assigned to the DCS for MCWEIS, CG-11 and H,CGWCEISC, in-charge with all the WCEIS requirements of PCG Offices and Units in support to the attainment of their mission;
 - b. To provide policies, guidance and procedures for recommending, processing, deliberating and conferring Daglis-Budyong Badge.
 - c. To serve as basis that only DCS for MCWEIS, CG-11 and H,CGWCEISC personnel (Signal Corpse, IT/Cyber Group, Communications and Electronics and Weapons Group) with WCEIS Badge can claim Hazardous Duty Pay in accordance with NHQ-PCG Circular No. 10-19.
- IV. SCOPE:** This circular applies to all PCG personnel assigned to the DCS for MCWEIS, CG-11 and CGWCEISC as per its salient provisions to receive the above-mentioned badge.

V. THE WCEIS BADGE:

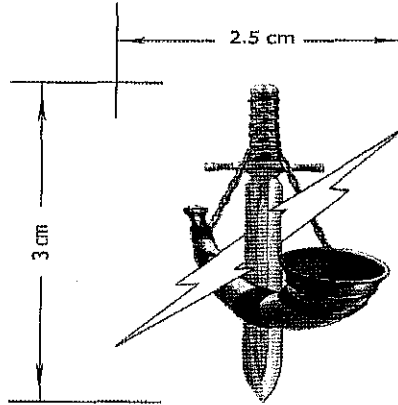
- a. **Description:** A lightning that penetrates through the sword with a horn hanging by the sword's cross-guard which represents the three functions of O/CG11 and HCGWCEISC mainly; weapon, communications and electronics. Daglis-Budyong Badge will render a silver blade while the grip of the sword is rendering a gold. This design symbolized the intact connection of all the officers and personnel working to attained their mission.

The design of the Daglis-Budyong Badge represents the following traditional and typical elements of the Coast Guard service:

1. Horn - Symbolizes giving of analog/digital information and signal through radio, cellular, satellite and internet protocol. Local name Budyong;
 2. Sword - Represents one of the functions of this Office, to provide strategic acquisition of armaments, materials and equipage requirements for operational readiness, combat support and interoperability, robust and reliable provisions (weapons) for PCG units. Local name Kalis;
 3. Lightning - Shows strong, secured and reliable communication within 4the organization for both commercial an-d tactical. Local name Dagitab
- b. **To Whom Awarded:** PCG Officers and Non-officers assigned to the DCS for MCWEIS, CG-11 and CGWCEISC (Signal Corpse, IT/Cyber Group, COMMELS and Weapon Group).
- c. **By Whom Awarded:** Commander, Coast Guard Weapons, Communications, Electronic and Information System Command, (C,CGWCEISC)
- d. **Requirements for the Award:**
1. Officer and Non-officer currently assigned of the DCCGs for MCWEIS, CG-11 and HCGWCEISC to include those who are previously assigned to the said Offices;
 2. Approval of C,CGWCEISC upon recommendation of the DCS for MCWEIS, CG-11

e. Dimensions:

1. Height – 3 cm
2. Width – 2.50 cm



VI. POLICY GUIDELINES:

- a. C,CGWCEISC upon recommendation of DCS for MCWEIS, CG-11 has the authority to approve and grant the badge to the personnel assigned at the DCS for MCWEIS. CG-11, CGWCEISC and the Honorary member of the Daglis-Budyong Badge
- b. C,CGWCEISC as designated approving authority will require eligibility (e.g. trainings, seminars and etc.) upon the approval and grant of Daglis-Budyong Badge.

VII. MANNER OF WEARING:

- a. Personnel currently performing duties involving WCEIS shall wear the Daglis-Budyong Badge at the center right breast pocket;
- b. Personnel not currently serving or have already completed their duties involving WCEIS shall wear the Daglis-Budyong Badge at the center left breast pocket.

VIII. TRANSITORY PROVISIONS:

- a. Upon approval and effectivity of this circular:
 1. Personnel currently assigned to the DCS for MCWEIS, CG-11 and CGWCEISC are entitled to the Daglis-Budyong Badge upon the recommendation of DCS for MCWEIS, CG-11 and with the approval of C,CGWCEISC;
 2. Personnel who have been previously assigned to the DCS for MCWEIS, CG-11 and CGWCEISC are also entitled to the Daglis-budyong Badge upon the submission of documentary evidence (e.g. assignment order) duly authenticated by CGAO.
 3. C,CGWCEISC shall ensure that certification and qualification procedures for acquiring Daglis-Budyong Badge are properly implemented before granting said award.

IX. RECISSION:


- a. Other policies that are inconsistent with this circular are hereby rescinded upon approval and effectivity of this circular.
